CRIME ALERT

BREAK AND ENTER TO RESIDENTIAL HOMES IN SUNSET AREA

Location: 400 E. 43rd Ave. and 300 E. 45th Ave.

Date: March 12th

Sometime during the day of March 12th a suspect entered a home by breaking the glass to the front door. The house alarm was triggered and probably scared off the intruder as no property was stolen. On the same day entry was attempted at another nearby home, again through the front door. It would appear that the suspect was also disturbed as entry was not gained.

TIPS

- consider solid doors without glass or install security glass like Lexan in place of glass
- a house alarm is an excellent target hardening measure
- keep a radio on when nobody is home
- have lights on timers
- keep a watchful eye on activity in your neighbourhood and report suspicious activity to police
