- *Willing to undergo and pass a criminal record check prior to the AGM to the satisfaction of the Neighbourhood Police Officer at the South Vancouver Community Policing Centre*
- *Committed to participate in at least 9 of 11 monthly board meetings*
- *Committed to working a minimum 4 volunteer hours (not including board meetings) per month by attending outreach events and to serving on a committee, and contributes additional volunteer hours in that capacity*
- *Able to demonstrate skills based on a number of years experience in the work force, such as Academic, Medical, Political, Public Service, Banking, Accounting, Marketing, Technology, Fund-raising, etc..*
- *Someone who enjoys working with people.*
- *Capable of professional communications and able to speak and write English fluently. Another language would be an asset.*
- *A resident and works in the Metro Vancouver and has some involvement in this area.*
- *To have had a least one year's experience as an active volunteer with a local volunteer organization (including the Society).*

The Board of Directors (maximum 15) attends once monthly board meeting, where business side of the organization is taken care of.
