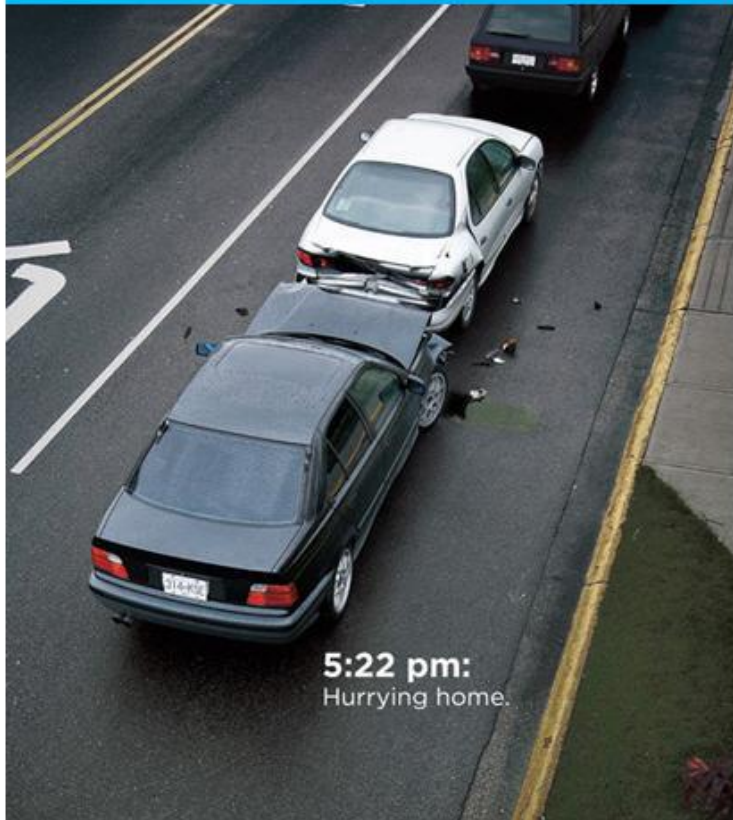

## We all have some bad habits...



The important thing is to recognize those habits and to change them.

We want all of our employees to be safe when traveling to and from work. Better yet, we want all of you to be safe whenever you're out on the road.

We're partnering with ICBC to remind you that you can drive safely through an intersection by exhibiting certain behaviours:

- **When making a left turn, be extra cautious and yield the right of way to oncoming traffic.**
- **Leave enough space between your car and the one in front of you.**
- **Leave early and allow for extra travel time in case of delays.**
- **Remember: yellow lights mean you should stop if you can do so safely.**
- **Watch for pedestrians at intersections.**
- **Slow down and drive smart.**

More than one million drivers have been involved in an intersection crash over the past five years.
